

COMMUNITY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

Schedule A-U - Residential Service

AVAILABILITY

Available throughout the Cooperative's service territory to residential consumers purchasing both electric distribution service and electricity supply service from the Cooperative subject to the Cooperative's Terms and Conditions of Service.

APPLICABILITY

This Schedule is applicable to consumers purchasing alternating electricity for single family residential and residential-farm use subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Other domestic or farm appliances and equipment may be supplied from the same meter provided they are a related facility of the residence with which they are connected and their use is primarily non-commercial.

This rate is not applicable to:

- (a) Separately metered farm or domestic facilities such as dryers, brooders, water pumps, etc.
- (b) Club houses, *trailer camps or any connection for temporary, seasonal or commercial use.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single phase, 60 cycle, at the Cooperative's standard voltages.

MONTHLY RATE

- I. Distribution Delivery Charges
 - A. Base Facilities Charge:
\$8.40 per month (plus)
 - B. Energy Delivery Charges:
 - First 200 KWH delivered @ \$0.03440 per KWH
 - Next 600 KWH delivered @ \$0.02339 per KWH
 - Over 800 KWH delivered @ \$0.01886 per KWH
- II. Plus Generation and Transmission Supply Charges:
All KWH @ \$0.05239 per KWH

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge under the foregoing rate shall be \$8.40 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of \$1.00 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. The consumer shall be entitled during the billing period to the use of the number of kilowatt-hours in accordance with the foregoing rate.

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

The amount of generation and transmission supply charges (II.) calculated under the above rates are subject to increase or decrease under provisions of the Cooperative's Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule "G."

TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of contract is to be not less than twelve (12) months.

- * House trailers or mobile homes mounted on permanent foundations and connected with permanent water and permanent Health Department approved sewerage facilities may be served under this Schedule.
