

COMMUNITY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

Schedule B-U - General Service

AVAILABILITY

Available throughout the Cooperative's service territory to general service consumers purchasing both electric distribution service and electricity supply service from the Cooperative subject to the Cooperative's Terms and Conditions of Service.

APPLICABILITY

This Schedule is applicable to any consumer purchasing alternating current electricity for all uses including lighting, heating and power up to 50 KW demand, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single phase, and three phase where available, 60 cycle, at the Cooperative's standard voltage.

MONTHLY RATE

- I. Distribution Facilities Charges
 - A. Base Facilities Charge:
\$8.40 per month
 - B. Energy Delivery Charges:
 - First 200 KWH delivered @ \$0.04972 per KWH
 - Over 200 KWH delivered @ \$0.02252 per KWH
- II. Plus Generation and Transmission Supply Charges:
All KWH @ \$0.05337 per KWH

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$8.40 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased by \$1.00 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. The consumer shall be entitled during the billing period to the use of the number of kilowatt-hours in accordance with the foregoing rate.

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE FOR SEASONAL SERVICE

Consumers requiring seasonal service shall remit a minimum annual payment of twelve (12) times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section. During each billing month that the service is connected, the account shall be credited with one twelfth (1/12) of the minimum annual payment and charges shall be levied in accordance with the foregoing sections. Only in the aforementioned manner shall any portion of the minimum annual charge be refunded or credited to any account. Extensions of facilities for seasonal purposes shall be made in accordance with Section XIV of the "Terms and Conditions of Service."

TEMPORARY SERVICE

Temporary service shall be supplied under the foregoing rate and made available in accordance with Section VI of the "Terms and Conditions of Service." The Cooperative may require a deposit, in advance, of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

The amount of generation and transmission supply charges (II.) calculated under the above rates are subject to increase or decrease under provisions of the Cooperative's Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule "G."

TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of contract is to be not less than twelve (12) months.
